COMPANIES AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY (REGISTRY) (AMENDMENT) BILL

- 1. The Bill for consideration is the Companies and Intellectual Property (Registry) (Amendment) Bill (the Bill).
- 2. The purpose of the Bill is to amend the Companies and Intellectual Property (Registry) Act, Cap. 13.02 (the Act).
- 3. Clauses 1 and 2 of the Bill provide for the short title and interpretation of the Bill.
- 4. Clause 3 of the Bill amends section 4(3) of the Act by deleting the reference to Schedule 2.
- 5. Clause 4 of the Bill repeals section 5 of the Act.
- 6. Clause 5 of the Bill repeals Schedule 2 of the Act which specifies the opening hours of the Registry of Companies and Intellectual Property.

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Companies and Intellectual Property (Registry) (Amendment) Act, 2020.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, "principal Act" means the Companies and Intellectual Property (Registry) Act, Cap. 13.02.

Amendment of section 4

3. Section 4(3) of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "or Schedule 2".

Repeal of section 5

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed.

Repeal of Schedule 2

5. Schedule 2 of the principal Act is repealed.
